New Guest Wireless Connection



If you are a Nook and Kindle user you may be having trouble connecting to the **Guest** Wireless hotspots. For now, the **Guest** network will operate the same with a user ID: *willow* and password: *valley*, upon connection to the Internet for all internet use. To accommodate the Readers, we have setup an additional wireless access account named **wvguest**. This connection only requires the password: *willowvalley1*.

Once the password is accepted, the Reader is connected to the Internet and can download books or access content from the Internet. The locations of the connection points are the same as the **Guest** hotspots. The number of connections that can be made at those hotspots will be shared between **Guest** and **wvguest**. Problems connecting to the Internet using the wireless access points should be reported to that community's Front Desk so a Support Ticket can be submitted to Information Technology.
